

MYRTLE has a beautifully draped cowl neckline, a comfortable and figure-skimming elasticized waist, and a flowing, gathered skirt with in-seam pockets. The skirt of **VERSION 1** falls just below the knee. **VERSION 2** features adjustable button-on shoulder tabs and an above-the-knee hemline.

- SUPPLIES: All-purpose thread, 1 1/2 yards of 1-inch elastic, two 1/4-inch buttons (version 2), ballpoint needles, twin needle.

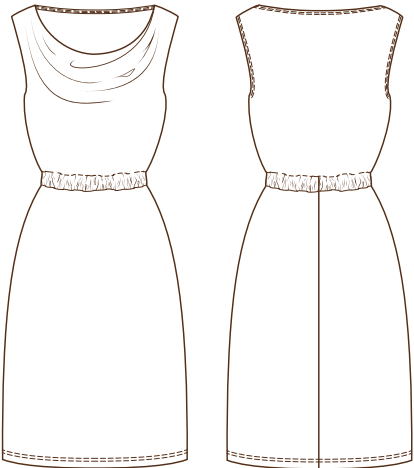

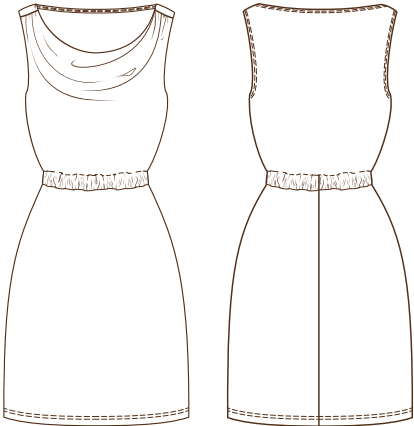
* Due to the drape and stretch of knit fabrics, the final garment will have positive ease in the bust and negative ease in the waist. Choose your size based on body measurements.
