Eugene is a timeless wardrobe staple. This classic henley will take you through any year or season, and has endless possibilities for customization. Play around with color blocking for the collar, placket, or sleeve cuffs. Instead of buttons, try snaps for the placket closure as shown in *Sewing Specifics (Seamwork, Issue 20)*. There are optional tailored details you can add to *Eugene* such as the reinforced back neckline with twill tape and side seam vent. You will be satisfied with this quick-sew project that can easily be incorporated into your wardrobe. Style *Eugene* with *Harrington (Seamwork, Issue 20)* or *Denali (Seamwork, Issue 11)* for an interchangeable outfit. *Eugene* is a casual classic that can be incorporated into any lifestyle.

SUPPLIES

All-purpose polyester sewing thread, one ballpoint needle, one twin needle, $\frac{3}{8}$ yard of lightweight fusible knit interfacing, three $\frac{5}{8}$ " buttons, $\frac{1}{2}$ yard of twill tape. Optional: An additional $\frac{3}{8}$ yards of twill tape.

MAIN FABRIC

Medium weight knit fabrics; cotton, rayon, or polyester blends such as ponte or french terry.

CONTRAST FABRIC

$\frac{3}{8}$ yard of lightweight woven fabric for the back yoke, such as cotton, linen, or chambray.
