

ABOUT LENNY

From weather to clothing to lifestyle, fall is all about transitions. Finding a garment to transition you through fall and winter, day and night, can be tricky. *Lenny* will do all that and more. It is a classic turtleneck dress, appropriate for both the office and nightlife. And because *Lenny* is a knit dress, it is both classy and comfortable. Use a solid-colored, merino wool knit to create a sleek look, or try a fun print for a dress with more flare. By layering *Lenny* with *Phoebe* (*Colette Patterns*), you can create a fun, vintage outfit. If you shorten the hem of *Lenny* to tunic length, it pairs well with a variety of skirts (such as *Beignet*, *Colette Patterns*). *Lenny* is a staple garment that will expand your winter wardrobe.

SUPPLIES

All-purpose polyester sewing thread, one ball point sewing machine needle, one ball point twin needle.

MAIN FABRIC

Medium weight knits with at least 50% stretch, such as French terry, ponte, cotton/rayon blends, and lightweight sweater knits.
